

Student Recreation Center

Grambling State University currently has an Intramural Recreation Center and a Natatorium facility, both of which are in need of expansion and improvement. The two facilities are in close proximity to one another, but they are distinctly separate buildings, and their primary entrances face away from each other.

Existing Conditions

With the relocation of the outdoor tennis facilities to the northwest corner of campus, a space will become available adjacent to both buildings that can serve as a new building site for an expanded Student Recreation Center. This new facility will be integrated with both existing recreation facilities to form one large, connected Student Recreation Center. New exercise space will be made available to students, and access to all indoor campus recreation amenities will be centrally managed. This will increase the use of these facilities and encourage students to maintain active, healthy lives.
